THEATRE INSTRUCTION EXPERIENCE

Acting Instructor for Acting II, Unibetsedåt Guåhan (University of Guam) 2022 This course helped actors discover their process and marry it with technical methods from Uta Hagen. Students used exercises from "Respect for Acting" in their contemporary and classical scene work, worked with scansion and text analysis of classical text, researched acting apprenticeship opportunities, and developed two monologues (a contemporary and a classical) to use as an audition package.

Theatre Instructor, Dear Tree Learning Center, Guam 2022 Led a small class of middle and high schoolers in improv exercises, theatre games, scenework, collaborative play writing, and rehearsals for a staged reading of their work.

Directing Instructor, Unibetsedåt Guåhan (University of Guam) 2021 This upper level course is required for all theatre majors regardless of focus. Students from a variety of backgrounds learn how to use the text as the foundation for all directorial choices, how to lead a room, how to collaborate effectively with both designers and actors, and how to develop their vision of a story. In a group of students ranging ages 8 to 11, this four week pilot program introduced them to age appropriate, fundamental acting skills such as physicalization, listening to scene partners, imagining given circumstances, and maintaining energy.

Acting Instructor for Introductory Acting, UC-Irvine 2016 This foundational course invited students to release inhibitions and discover their unique artistic voice through games, exercises, and partner work while also introducing basic acting techniques and terminology.

Acting Instructor for Scene Study and Audition Technique, UC- Irvine 2016 With an emphasis on Stanislavski and other great teachers of Modern American Acting, this foundational acting technique course focused on the application of characterization, given circumstances, and activated language to audition pieces. This course also introduced students to the business elements of auditioning.
